General Information

Changes to the 2026 Syllabus

- There are various changes in the new 2026 Piano Grade Syllabus.
- The repertoire lists have been revised and include a mixture of new and retained pieces.
- Changes with regards to the genre exercises levels.

What is new in the 2026 Syllabus

- New music pieces for different levels are now included.
- Sections will now be played together with backtracks.
- Some sections have more than one option to choose from with regards to selection of a backtrack.
- New sections have been added to some of the grades.

Rules with regards to backtracks

- Only the backtracks that is prescribed are allowed to be used. No changes or replacement backtracks are allowed during examinations.
- The correct backtrack must be used during examinations as indicated in the backtrack list.
- Sections that is required to be presented with backtracks will have a sign next to it. This sign is similar to the one below.

Syllabus Layout

Technical Section

Candidates are required to prepare the following sections for examinations:

1. Sight Reading

Requirements for this section will be set out as per publication. There are samples of music passages that can be expected to be used during examinations. Sight reading that must be used during the exams will be supplied to teachers before the time.

2. Practical Musicianship

Requirements for this section will be set out as per publication. There are samples of music passages that can be expected to be used during examinations.

3. Scales

a) One of the following Major scales must be prepared for the exams.

B^b Major Scale

Must be played as shown in the publication. Tempo of ♩ = 115.
Scales must be played with backtrack.

D Major Scale

Must be played as shown in the publication. Tempo of ♩ = 100.
Scales must be played with backtrack.



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b) One of the following minor scales must be prepared.

- * Must be prepared as a standard scale.
- * Can be Harmonic or Melodic.
- * Hands together and hands separately.
- * Two octaves.
- * Scales must be played without a backtrack.
- * Tempo of ♩ = 100.

Technical Section

Candidates are required to prepare the following sections for examinations:

4. Genre Style

One of the following genre styles must be prepared for the exams.

1. *The candidate must choose one of these Genre styles given.*
2. *This chosen style must then be transposed into the key signature as required in the Genre exercise: **B^b Major***
3. *Candidate may be assisted by teacher with the transposing.*
4. *It will be required from the candidate to explain how transposing was done.*
5. *This transposed Genre must then be played.*
6. *The given tempo of the style must be kept.*
7. *Exercise must be played without backtrack.*

Genre Styles: *Waltz or Country*

5. Arpeggios

Candidates must be prepared to play one of the following arpeggios. These arpeggios must be played two octaves, separate hands, ascending and descending, in the root position only.

6. Chord Construction

Must be able to explain what a chord is and demonstrate on instrument as per publication. Must know and mention the Jazz formula during the exam.

7. Improvisation

Improvisation is required as per this grade. Candidate is required to know the definition of the techniques, and must point out where it was used in the music piece.

List A - Improvisation

Candidates are required to prepare the following section for examinations:

8. List A

Please keep the following in mind when preparing the section:

- 1) One piece must be selected and played for List A.
- 2) Improvisation is required for this grade, candidates must make use of improvisation technique. Chords must be added in open bars. Chord changes or improvements are allowed.
- 3) The set tempo of the music piece must be kept as written. No changes are allowed.
- 4) Music pieces are NOT allowed to be replaced by any other piece, even if it is the same music piece but just written differently.
- 5) This music piece may be presented with or without a backtrack. Should the candidate present it with a backtrack, then it will be the responsibility of the candidate to obtain his/her own backtrack. A backtrack can be requested from The Academy at an additional fee for the candidate.
- 6) Make sure that the music piece is repeated if written so.
- 7) Candidate must know the give viva voce and mention it before playing the music piece.

List B - As Written

Candidates are required to prepare the following section for examinations:

9. List B

Please keep the following in mind when preparing the section:



- 1) One piece must be selected and played for List B.
- 2) This music piece must be played as written, NO changes are allowed to be made.
- 3) The set tempo of the music piece must be kept as written. No changes are allowed.
- 4) Music pieces are NOT allowed to be replaced by any other piece, even if it is the same music piece but just written differently.
- 5) This music piece must be presented with a backtrack. Please ensure that the correct backtrack is used during examinations. No changes are allowed.
- 6) Make sure that the music piece is repeated if written so.
- 7) Candidate must know the give viva voce and mention it before playing the music piece.



Backtrack must be used as indicated.

List C - Own Choice

Candidates are required to prepare the following section for examinations:

10. List C

Please keep the following in mind when preparing the section:

- 1) One piece must be selected and played for List C.
- 2) Although not required for this grade, candidates can make use of improvisation techniques. Chords can be added in open bars. Chord changes or improvements are allowed.
- 3) The set tempo of the music piece must be kept as written. No changes are allowed.
- 4) Music pieces are NOT allowed to be replaced by any other piece, even if it is the same music piece but just written differently.
- 5) This music piece may be presented with or without a backtrack. Should the candidate present it with a backtrack, then it will be the responsibility of the candidate to obtain his/her own backtrack. A backtrack can be requested from The Academy at an additional fee for the candidate.
- 6) Make sure that the music piece is repeated if written so.
- 7) Ensemble spell is compulsory for this piece. Refer to explanation in the publication.
